OUR COLLEGE

Tranquebar, “The queen of the Coramandal coast” has rich tradition and a glorious past. It is the symbol of the Portuguese- Danish- French- English Heritage. The Institute of Salesian Missionaries of Mary Immaculate (SMMI) arrived Tranquebar in 1901 in order to uplift the downtrodden. St. Theresa’s Convent has been travelling with the local communities since 1901. Prominently, it has provided significant education in the region through running of schools and we have the biggest home for children in our state having 879 children where, many very poor, deprived and destitute children stay and go to school. The girl students who complete their Higher Secondary School Education fail to pursue higher education, which is primarily owing to economic deprivation coupled with cultural factor. Most of these girls are from the poor and marginalized communities of Tharangambadi region.

Considering the plight of the above less privileged youth girls to pursue their Higher Education, The General and her council, the Provincial and her council permitted to start a College for women at Sathangudi, Tharangambadi.

St. Theresa’s Arts and Science College for Women was founded in 2017 August. It was affiliated to Bharathidasan University, Thiruchirapalli. Since 2021-2022 our college came under the aegis of Annamalai University as per the G.O of

TamilNadu Government. It is the Minority Catholic educational institution, established and administrated by the sisters of Salesian Missionaries of Mary Immaculate belonging to the Society of Mary Immaculate.

It is primarily meant for the higher education of deserving Catholics, but members of other communities are also admitted without reference to caste or creed and their rights of conscience are respected.

Abiding by the teaching of our founders, the college commits itself to empower the women and the poor, who are less privileged. Our founders had directed us in the school of St. Francis de Sales, who was captured by the meek and gentle Jesus. We pay keen interest in imparting Salesian virtues like gentleness, patience, meekness, simplicity and cheerfulness.

RULES AND CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

Each Salesian student is looked upon as an individual endowed by God with certain talent with her own character and personality which must be developed and perfected. Salesian looks at each of her students to uphold the standard of the college in and outside and also throughout her life.

- 1. The official medium of instruction will be English.**
- 2. Identity cards for all students will be issued soon after their admission into the college. Every student has to wear her identity card every day. The card will be valid for three years for U.G. students. Identity card is absolutely essential during the examination day and for obtaining scholarship /Certificates, Library Entry etc.**
- 3. The students should personally approach the staff members for personal development. Students should greet their teachers, if there see them front on the day, Students and staff should expressively avoid doing anything by word and deed which may disturb the unity and harmony of life both in the college and hostel.**
- 4. Students should be respectful towards the authorities of the management.**
- 5. The authorities of the management are directly in charge of the integral formation of the students. The students should make use of this opportunity to get all the guidance needed.**

6. Since the students opt English as the medium of Instruction they should speak in English in the college as well as in the hostel. Any violation will call for penalty.
7. Students should maintain cleanliness and safe guard the properties of the Institution.
8. Every student should be in time for the college.
9. Students should not leave the Class / college without the permission of the staff / principal.
10. Students should not take leave without the submission of leave letters signed by the parent / guardian.
11. Students should not take part in the activities of any political party or political agitation.
12. Cell phones are strictly prohibited in the college campus.
13. The management has every right to punish the students for their misbehavior. (The way of levy of fines, withholding of certificates, suspension and expulsion, etc)
14. All types of communications to the students will be put up on the notice board. They are asked to see the notice board daily.
15. All the students are directed to follow the hierarchy i.e. the class teacher, HOD, Principal when they face any problem.
16. Payment of fees to the college / University should be made before prescribed last date, in case of failing to pay fees, fine will be imposed.

DRESS CODE

Staff and students are expected to be neatly dressed in accordance with the rules of approved decency and modesty. Every first Monday and on celebration days, staff and students are expected to come in Uniform. Leggings, net shawl, short tops, T- Shirt, and Jeans are not allowed. During the festival, Special permission will be given to wear sarees and half sarees.

ATTENDANCE

1. For all the students, attendance as prescribed by Annamalai University, Chidambaram (75%) and also by the college is quite essential and the college emphasizes on the attendance of every student to be maximum number of working days. No student shall be absent from the college without proper leave letter. Application for leave must be made beforehand on information to the Principal and the same should be countersigned by the Parent / Guardian and recommended by the concerned staff member in charge of the class through the H.O.D. Leave application for the hostellers should bear the recommendation of the deputy warden of the hostel.
2. Only if the absence is due to unforeseen circumstances and if the leave has been availed, the application for leave must be submitted as early as possible, i.e., the next working day.
3. If a student is late for an hour, she will not be admitted inside the class unless she produces the Hand book with the "Late Entry" to the lecturer.

- 4. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of every session. A student who is not in the class when attendance is taken will be marked absent.**
- 5. A student requiring leave from a class or a portion of a class must apply for it in person to the Class-in-charge of the class. If she wishes to leave the college, she should meet the Principal or the Head of Department and get her\his consent. If she is a hosteller she should get the consent of the warden.**
- 6. No leave will be granted during internal exams and university Exams. In case of serious illness, a medical certificate is to be produced signed by the Govt. Recognised Doctor with her / his seal and registration number.**
- 7. Attendance for all association meetings and college functions are binding on both staff and students.**
- 8. Staff and students must be present on the re-opening day and on the last working day.**

Library Cards :

ID Card is compulsory for entry into the library.

Rules:

- 1. Strict silence shall be observed in the library.**
- 2. No member shall take any printed book or notebook into the library.**
- 3. Signing in the register at the library entrance is compulsory for staff and students.**
- 4. Students can borrow only two books at a time,**
- 5. Books must not be marked or defaced. Students should examine each book before borrowing it and report to the librarian of any damage found there in.**
- 6. Periodicals placed on the magazine racks should not be mishandled. They should be replaced on the racks after use in order.**

7. Reference books and periodicals will not be issued but are available for reference within the library.
8. Books when in use must always be kept intact.
9. Books borrowed by the students should be returned within 7 days. If a student fails to return the book on the due date will have to pay Rs. 5/- per day.
10. All books shall be returned to the library three days before closing of each term.
11. After getting prior permission and as per instructions of the librarian you can make use of the computer facility in the library.
12. Duplicate cards will be issued on payment of Rs. 100/- and on the recommendation of the Tutor.

DISCIPLINE

1. Discipline is a hall mark of character and hence our topmost priority is on disciplines which, if strictly adhered to, will automatically enable any student to be good in studies as well. Discipline essentially depends upon two factors,
 - (i). Implicit obedience to the prescribed rules and
 - (ii). Faithfulness to the Institution.
2. At the ringing of the first bell all the students are expected inside their respective class room and with the entrance of the staff members into the classroom all the students should stand up and greet the staff. All the

students should respond to the call of attendance which will be taken every hour.

- 3. Late coming is to be avoided; late comers will be levied penalty. Absentees will have to get the signature of the concerned HOD and the Principal before the classes begin.**

ELIGIBILITY OF ADMISSION

The candidates who are provisionally selected for admission will be intimated. They have to pay the fees before the due date.

The following should be produced at the time of admission.

- a. Transfer and conduct certificate in original.**
- b. TamilNadu Higher Secondary Certificate (or its equivalent certificate in original)**
- c. Candidates who have passed an examination other than TamilNadu Higher Secondary should produce Eligibility Certificate from Annamalai University, Chidambarm.**
- d. Three passport size photographs (2.5' * 2")**
- e. Community Certificate Original and Two Photocopies (Xerox) attested by a Gazzetted officers.**
- f. Aadhar Xerox.**
- g. Saving passbook Xerox.**

ADMISSION

Application for U.G programs should be submitted within 10 working days from the publication of the +2 examination results. Applications received thereafter may not be considered. If the certificates are found to be bogus, admission is liable for cancelation, besides criminal action being taken.

Application for P.G Programs may be submitted within a week after the Publication of the U.G result.
